He and Moya ran a very successful pub business for several years. They later moved to Brighton where John worked in Interior Design using his design and artistic skills.

"John's final working years were spent in the care industry, mainly in the NHS, helping with autistic and vulnerable adults.

"John had a wide range of interests, painting, drafting and design, music from Heavy Metal to Opera, and Poetry. He was also a voracious reader.

"I found John to be an intelligent, informed, cultured and a well-read person."

John was always open, welcoming and approachable. He was well-liked in the Club and we will miss him.
